

# **TYLER'S RESERVE POOL RULES**

## **For Use by Resident Members and Their Guests Only**

- Pool Hours are 9am-9pm daily.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY-SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. SWIMMING ALONE IS NOT PERMITTED.
- A Tyler's Reserve resident must be in attendance with guests. Only 2 guests per resident at any time. Fobs should not be given to guests.
- Tyler's Reserve residents must use a fob to enter the facility.
- Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Nannies and babysitters, ages 16 and up, may bring children to the pool. However, the children must always be supervised.
- All incontinent individuals are required to wear waterproof pants.
- Proper swim attire must always be worn.
- No glass permitted in the pool area.
- No pets permitted in the pool area.
- Pool furniture is not to be placed in the pool & must remain in the pool area.
- No running, horseplay or unsafe activity is permitted.
- No diving is permitted.
- Do not keep gates open – gates must be closed after entering and exiting the pool.
- No articles of any kind are to be draped or hung on fences.
- No smoking, vaping or use of smokeless tobacco of any kind.
- Speakers of any kind must be kept at a reasonable volume level.
- No large flotation devices such as rafts, hammocks, loungers, or rideable floats allowed in the pool.
- No skateboards, scooters or bikes permitted in the pool area.
- The Association will not be responsible for loss of personal property or personal injury to Members and/or their Guests.
- Rules subject to change at any time without notice.

*It is the responsibility of each property owner to see that these rules are enforced to maintain a safe area for the use and recreation of all Property Owners. The pool rules are intended to create a safe and enjoyable environment for all Property Owners.*
